Director's Message

Welcome to Community Players' production of *Death of a Salesman*.

When I was a high school teacher, I read and taught this play many, many times, and I always wanted to direct it. The Players have given me this opportunity, and I am so thankful to them. I am also very grateful for a cast and crew that have dedicated themselves to this production.

Arthur Miller wrote the classic *Death of a Salesman* in 1949, and it was the recipient of the Pulitzer Prize for Drama and Tony Award for Best Play, and many critics consider it the greatest American play of all-time. The drama focuses on Willy Loman, a traveling salesman who is struggling with his work and his family. The play addresses many issues, including the American Dream, aging, loss of identity, the inability to accept reality, the loss of mental stability, love, relationships, living in the past, flaws in logic, regret, and individual desires. That is quite a list, yes? Very profound and very powerful.

Miller said that he “imagined that with the possible exception of a doctor saving a life, writing a play was the most important thing a human could do” and that playwriting meant “grabbing people and shaking them by the back of the neck.” He also said that “...the prime business of a play is to arouse the passions of its audience.” I hope that our production of *Death of a Salesman* arouses those passions in you and that you reflect on this play and its characters and issues for a long time to come.


