Proposed change to the By-Laws

There has been a proposal to amend the By-Laws at the next regular meeting.

For By-Law 4, Section A, the current content is:

Auditions for any production of Players shall be conducted in such a manner as to afford each person an equal opportunity to read, dance, and/or sing. Actors will be allowed the opportunity to audition for the role of their choice and interact with more than one actor opposite them in a reading.

The proposal adds the following line:

A member of the Board of Directors, not involved in casting decisions, shall be present at all auditions to verify conformity with these procedures.

Our fall show is "Matilda, the Musical," based on the Roald Dahl classic. In February we present "One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest," based on the novel and award-winning film. April's show is "Senior Follies," a farce about the risqué goings on in a Senior Community Center. In June, the final show of the season is "Jesus Christ, Superstar," the Andrew Lloyd Webber classic.

If you ever glance at our website, you can find our monthly financial reports. You will quickly see that we present outstanding community theater on a relatively small budget. Also, you can see that our Patrons



account for about a third of our revenue. Your donations, in addition to covering your admission, help to keep the cost of tickets down for those in our community who have fewer financial resources. We truly appreciate your continued support.

We are enclosing the patron form for the upcoming season. It has been revised and hopefully simplified. The donation amounts for the various recognition levels have been adjusted after being flat for many years.

Please choose attendance dates for our shows. While the dates for Matilda are firm, the dates for the other three shows are the ones we requested from Wor-Wic and the Wicomico County Board of Education. Unfortunately, their policies prevent us from getting confirmed dates this early. If we must change the dates, we will try to make it as simple for you (and for us!) as possible. If you need to change your dates, we will make every effort to accommodate you. We ask that you give us an email address that you use regularly if you have one, since email communication tends to be faster and less expensive.

We plan to hold the annual Patrons Reception on the opening night of Jesus Christ, Superstar. An invitation will be sent out in the spring.
