
Since we were not able to fill our production team, the **Leading Men & Leading Ladies Concert on the Lawn** which was scheduled for October has been postponed. We hope to reschedule the concert for a fine Spring 2022 weekend when production team members are more readily available and less shows are in production at the same time. New dates and times as well as audition information will be published gs soon as those decisions are finalized.



We dare you to experience *Edgar Allan Poe: The Dark Side*, a live, memorized, word-for word telling of the darker works of Poe. The first-person narratives allow the audience to capture the transformation of the storytellers, who will not only rely on memory, but also will use their acting skills for a very dramatic presentation. Featured works include The Tell-Tale Heart, The Raven, Annabelle Lee, The Imp of the Perverse, The Cask of Amontillado, and The Black Cat. Serving as moderators are three women from Poe's life: his mother, his wife, and his fiancée, who introduce each work and provide intriguing biographical details, speaking to Poe as if he were there in the audience.



Venues and dates and times for the Poe Show are as follows: Kylan Barn in Delmar, MD, Friday, Oct. 22, at 7:30 p.m.; MarVa Theater in Pocomoke, MD, Saturday, Oct. 23, at 7:30 p.m.; The Brick Room in Salisbury, MD, Thursday, Oct. 28, at 7:30 p.m.; Moose Lodge in Salisbury, MD, Friday, Oct. 29, at 7:30 p.m.; and Cactus Taverna in Salisbury, MD, October 31, at 7 p.m. The Halloween performance is a dinner theater includes the show for \$10 (cash or check) and dinner (credit card accepted) for \$34 plus tax, tips, and alcoholic drinks.



The idea for it came in 1970, when Frayn was watching a performance of a farce that he had written from the wings. He said, "It was funnier from behind than in front, and I thought that one day I must write a farce from behind."[1] The play has been nominated for scores of awards for the original and revivals on Broadway and has been a favorite for each subsequent generation of audiences that have laughed through the mayhem.

During every show, actors put on makeup as they prepare for each performance. During shows with larges casts, this creates a major traffic jam at the makeup counter. A few of us have purchased our own makeup so that we can move away from that traffic jam and do own makeup apart from the crowd. If you are planning to do multiple shows and are interested in ordering your own starter makeup kit, Players is taking orders for Mehron Mini-Pro Makeup Kits. The kit comes in three shades: Fair/Olive Fair, Medium/Olive Medium, or Medium Dark/Dark. Each kit includes an 8 color cream palette (4 CreamBlend foundation shades and 4 accent shades), Colorset powder, eyeliner pencil, stipple sponge, non-latex sponge, powder puff, and an instruction booklet. The price for each kit will be \$25.00 and will include a case.
