



Mary was a strong-willed woman with a childlike enthusiasm and zest for life. She brought boundless joy to Players since 1969, and will be forever remembered enjoying the view of each day's sunrise or sunset, usually wearing one of her many brightly colored hats.

#### Trivia by Sharon Benchoff (March Women's History Month Trivia--See how well you know these wonderful women born in March.)

1. She Played Dorothy in the film "The Wiz".

2. Olivia Wilde made her Broadway debut in 2017 in this George Orwell play.

3. In 1975 she replaced Gwen Verdon in Chicago and in 1997 replaced Julie Andrews in Victor Victoria.

4. One of her most notable roles on stage was Norma Desmond in the Andrew Lloyd Webber production of Sunset Boulevard, for which she won her third Tony Award, playing the role on Broadway in 1993–94.

5. She was a four year member of the Arena Stage in Washington, D.C. in such roles as Emily in Our Town, Honey in Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf? You may know her better from her roles in The Birdcage and Edward Scissorhands.

6. She has won the Tony Award for Best Actress in a Musical twice, in 2002 for her role as Millie in Thoroughly Modern Millie, and in 2011 for her role as Reno Sweeney in Anything Goes. Other Broadway credits include Little Women, The Drowsy Chaperone, and Violet. She is now Marion the Librarian.

7. In 2009, she appeared in Broadway's God of Carnage with Marcia Gay Harden, James Gandolfini and Jeff Daniels, for which she received a Tony Award nomination for Best Leading Actress in a Play. In 2009, she was cast as Hillary Clinton in the BBC / HBO film The Special Relationship, released in 2010.

8. Born into a family of actors, she made her Broadway debut in 1967, and performed in several stage productions in New York City while making frequent returns to London's West End. She performed with her sister Vanessa in Three Sisters in London.

9. She received great reviews for her roles in the film versions of the musicals Chicago and Hairspray.

10. In February 2020, she and her husband Matthew starred in a revival of Neil Simon's Plaza Suite which is scheduled to open on Broadway this spring.

# **Community Players of Salisbury Scholarship**

The Community Players of Salisbury, Inc is one of the oldest continuously operating community theaters in Maryland. In 1937 a group of 26 charter members hoped to bring culture and pure entertainment to the Eastern Shore while providing an outlet for people interested in dramatics. Players was organized under the Recreation Division of the Works Progress Administration (WPA) in May of 1938.

Each spring Community Players of Salisbury will award grants up to \$500 to two high school seniors from Somerset, Worcester, Wicomico County and/or Delmar area public, private or home-schooled programs, depending on suitable applicants and availability of funds.

Students wishing to apply for this scholarship must:

A. Be a graduating high school senior in a Somerset, Worcester, Wicomico County or Delmar public, private or home school program

B. Have applied for admission to a post-secondary institution

C. Have participated in Community Players of Salisbury productions or be a member

of a family that has participated in Community Players of Salisbury productions.

D. Have financial need as evidenced by the FAFSA

The award shall be made under the following specific conditions:

1. Each candidate must submit a completed Community Players of Salisbury scholarship application.

2. The scholarship shall be paid directly to the student and shall be used for payment of normal school expenses such as tuition, school fees, room, board or books.

3. Student or their family must have participated in Community of Players of Salisbury productions.

4. Final selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Board of Directors of the Community Players of Salisbury.

5. Winner will be announced during the student's senior award program or at a Community Players of Salisbury function or meeting.
