Dearest Theater lovers,



Trivia by Sharon Benchoff (May Broadway Birthdays Theatre Trivia)

1. He wrote this beloved play about the boy who lives in Neverland.

2. The 2002 jukebox musical **Movin' Oút** features the songs of this singer/songwriter.

3. This actor is part of a theatrical family including his father Junius Brutus and brother Edwin, but is most famous for his Ford's Theatre appearance on April 14,1865.

4. He wrote the music and lyrics of **Annie Get Your Gun**, based on the life

of sharpshooter Annie Oakley.

- 5. His Broadway stage production of Shakespeare's "Julius Caesar" (1937)-in which the setting was changed to a modern Fascist Rome still remains, the longest-running Broadway production of the play. You may know him from his broadcast of "The War of the Worlds" or Citizen Kane.
- 6. This author's characters evolved into *The Wiz* and *Wicked*.
- 7. Maybe best known for his films including **12 Angry Men** and **On Golden Pond**, this actor also starred in **Our Town** and **Mr. Roberts** on Broadway.
- 8. Robert Morse (not Ken Johnson) originated the role of J. Pierrépont Finch in this musical.
- 9. One of the most acclaimed actors of the 20th century, born May 22, 1907, this Brit made his mark in many of Shakespeare's leading roles, including those of Hamlet, Henry V, Anthony, Richard III and Macbeth. 10. After starting to act in a London theatre club at the age of 15, he began
