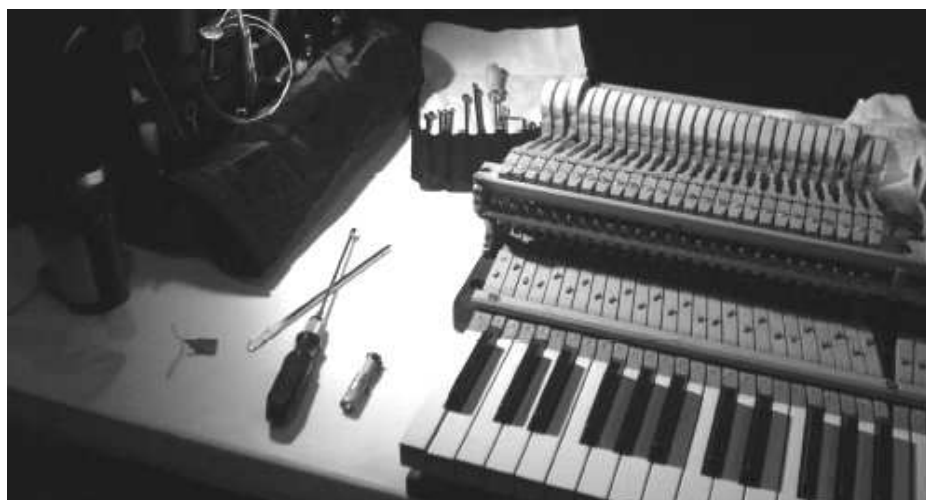

Synopsis

On Golden Pond is the love story of Ethel and Norman Thayer, who are returning to their summer home on Golden Pond for the forty-eighth year. He is a retired professor, nearing eighty, with heart palpitations and a failing memory — but still as tart-tongued, observant and eager for life as ever. Ethel is ten years younger, and the perfect foil for Norman who delights in all the small things that have enriched and continue to enrich their long life together.

They are visited by their divorced, middle-aged daughter and her dentist fiancé, who then go off to Europe, leaving his teenage son behind for the summer. The boy quickly becomes the “grandchild” the elderly couple has longed for.

As Norman revels in taking him fishing and thrusting good books at him, he also learns some lessons about modern teenage awareness — and slang — in return. In the end, as the summer’s end nears, so does their brief idyll.

In the final, deeply moving moments of the play, Norman and Ethel are brought even closer together by the incidence of a mild heart attack. Time, they know, is now against them, but the years have been good and, perhaps, another summer on Golden Pond still awaits them.

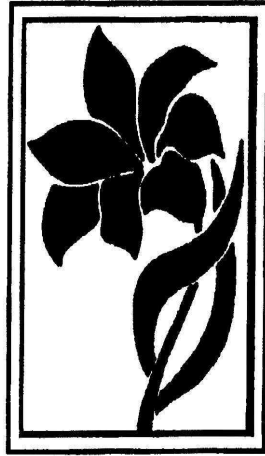

Who's Who in the Cast

Jeffrey Baer (Bill Ray) had the lead role in *Jekyll & Hyde*, *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown* and *Godspell* for the Players. He is usually found in the orchestra pit. His very first endeavor with the Players was as the Music Director for our 1995 production of *Oliver!* He was Musical Director for *Annie*, *The Wizard of Oz*, *Meet Me in St Louis*, *How to Succeed in Business*, and he played keyboards for *Hello Dolly* and *Bye, Bye Birdie*, and *They're Playing Our Song*.

Bobbie Calloway (Ethel Thayer) has been with Players for many years. She loves being on stage and helping back stage with props, painting and construction. Her favorite shows were *Guys and Dolls*, *Sound of Music*, *South Pacific*, *Fiddler on the Roof*, and *Steel Magnolias*. Thanks Rusty for believing I can do this!

Bob Connelly (Norman Thayer Jr.) has been performing with Players long enough to have been in 2 separate productions of *My Fair Lady* and *On Golden Pond*. He has been cast in many Players productions including *Ten Little Indians*, *I Remember Mama*, *Twelve Angry Men*, *Solid Gold Cadillac*, *Dial M For Murder*, *Run For Your Wife*, *The Mouse That Roared*, *You Can't Take It With You*, and *Foxfire*.

Steve Culver (Charlie Martin) was most recently seen in the Players' production of *Oliver!* and *The Odd Couple*. Steve appeared in many shows in the late 1970s at Laurel High School and with Possum Point Players. He also played Prince Dauntless in Salisbury State Theatre's 1978 production of *Once Upon A Mattress* and Motel in Masque Dinner Theatre's 1979 production of *Fiddler On The Roof*.
